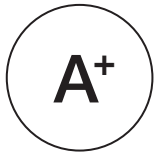


# NATURAL TEAK WOOD

## Features and Benefits



### Contract Quality (Grade A)

Grade A teak is cut from the center of mature timber for an incredibly uniform colour, finish, and hardness. Unlike lesser grades, A-grade teak maintains its integrity as it gracefully weathers while resisting degradation.



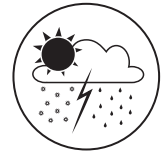
### Durable

Teak's natural oil repels water and prevents it from warping, cracking becoming brittle, which helps teak retain its shape and good looks for many years.



### Easy Care

Remove moss, dirt, and surface stains, with an occasional wash with soapy water and a soft nylon brush. For added surface resistance, we recommend applying clear natural linseed oil Golden Care® Teak Protector, or a natural teak oil.



### Environment Resistant

Teak has a demonstrated ability to withstand the harsh effects of the weather as it has a natural oil that repels water and prevents it from warping, cracking or becoming brittle. Teak can be left outside all year round, even in extreme weather conditions.

## Teak Colour Variations

Teak is a tropical hardwood with a raw, natural colour. Over time, as teak is exposed to outdoor elements, it gradually changes to a silver-grey patina. In moist climates, teak will weather more quickly. We recommend applying clear natural linseed oil, Golden Care® Teak Protector or a natural teak oil to maintain a golden-brown colour.

## FAQ's

### Which teak care product do you recommend?

If you choose to apply oil to your furniture, we recommend using clear natural linseed oil (not boiled), Golden Care® Teak Protector or a natural teak oil.

### How often do I need to apply the teak protector?

Depending on your environment, the raw, natural colour may change within 4-8 weeks. We recommend that you apply clear natural linseed oil, Golden Care® Teak Protector or a natural teak oil every 6-12 months while exposed to sun, humidity, rain, and other outdoor elements.

### Should I use water or oil-based care products?

We only recommend clear natural linseed oil, Golden Care® Teak Protector or any suitable teak oil.

### How do I clean my teak furniture?

Remove moss, dirt, and surface stains with an occasional wash with soapy water and a soft nylon brush.

### How do I apply Teak Protector

Please refer to the manufacturer's instructions for optimal results.

### Should I cover my teak furniture?

While not required, we offer all-weather covers for our fire table collections.
